The Paul Foundation in collaboration with the Lymphoma Research Foundation hosted their first fundraising event on September 12 at Bobby Van's Steakhouse in New York City. The event, which featured unique Live and Silent Auction prizes and Texas Hold'em, was attended by nearly 300 guests and raised close to \$350K, far exceeding expectations.

The Paul Foundation was founded in September of 2012 after the passing of Paul Walker Schaffel. Paul was 21 years old and a senior at Wesleyan University when he was diagnosed with Anaplastic Large Cell Lymphoma (ALCL). He passed away less than a year later.

The mission of The Paul Foundation is, among other things, to fund ALCL research and provide those affected by the disease and their families along with healthcare professionals with the tools to treat and cure ALCL. The Paul Foundation will heighten awareness of ALCL and further provide outreach for young people on college campuses.

"Making Strides Against Breast Cancer" at Jones Beach


